necessary, he lives at Terschelling, an Island in the Northern part of The Netherlands.






ROB DE VISSER



Jan 's hobbies are nowadays, searching at the internet, reading electronic newspapers, reading nautical magazines, listen to the scanner, and sitting at the beach, (if the weather is fine) and listen to spoken books, and off course reading the daily shipping newsletter.
