AAD NOORLAND

JACOB PIETER VAN HEEREN



Jaap was born 22 october 1944 in Dubbeldam, At the age of nine, in 1953, he was introduced to the salvage world because of the big flood of Holland. Many river vessels around Dordrecht, had ended up on dry land and had to be pulled back into the rivers. The company doing many of these jobs was called "van der Ende" from Dordrecht. Dordrecht, by the way was for many years the home base of Van der Tak but that was well before his time.. Jaap thought that this salvage work was the end of the world and it that it would be really nice to be able to do that kind of work. (what a mistake) After having finished my military service in the Navy, he joined "Van der Ende" and two years later "van der Tak" The first sheerleg he worked on was the "Arend", 200 ton capacity and with a coal fired boiler which was being converted to diesel fuel.

After many years all over the place **Jaap** ended up in England, working for the subsidiary called Risdon Beazley, with the site office in Middlesbrough. This lasted five years and at around that time **Smit** had bought over a company in Singapore and he was asked if he would like to join that company because the equipment from England was being transferred there.

Since he had never been so far from home and **Jaap** liked the adventure, and decided to go there. Jaap is have been working around the Far East ever since with an occasional project in Africa. In 1985 he started the successful Smit FELS joint venture company Asian Lift, which is still running today and also started the initial talks in the direction of the Keppel SMIT harbor towing joint venture but this only started officially after he left Smit. One of the highlights of my career was the salvage of the jack-up barge Al Baz, off the coast of Nigeria in '91/92. At the moment **Jaap** is employed as Marine Coordinator with Talisman Energy, based in Malaysia.
