Although the moving took place in last July and all activities started as from that moment at the new location, the whole moving-project was more or less finalized in November. The last few months Vlierodam paid a lot of attention to, besides production and trading, implementation of all adjustments and making sure that operating from the new location will go as efficient as possible. With a new testing bench (cap. 200 T), multiple overhead travelling cranes, several new recourses and a renewed stock policy Vlierodam will achieve a higher service-level. After serving for more then 35 years at the former location lacked on suitability to the current and future activities, in order to keep up with the developments and to increase the capacity building this new establishment was necessary.
